Subject: Extension of validity of tapering linkage to M/s. Nalwa Steel and Power Ltd - reg

Sir.

I am directed to refer to CIL's letter No. CIL/S&M/ Sponge/MoC/ 255 dated 11.8.2009 on the above mentioned subject and to say that the matter has been examined in the Ministry. Vide this Ministry's letter No. 23011/7/2007-CPD dated 10.7.2009 wherein the extension of tapering linkage of sponge iron units was intimated to CIL, it was clarified that three years of tapering linkage should be reckoned from the date of submission of Mining Plan or three years from the date of actual supplies under tapering linkage, whichever is earlier and that supplies would be restricted to a maximum period of three years. It is also clarified that all relevant aspects have duly been considered by Competent Authority, while considering extension.

2. CIL/SECI are, therefore, requested to take further necessary action for implementation of this Ministry's instructions dated 4.8.2009 under intimation to this Ministry. Other cases where extension for tapering linkage has been communicated to CIL after 10.7.2009 may also be regulated accordingly.

3. It is further directed that whenever in future more clarifications are sought after the instructions are issued by the Ministry of Coal on a reference from CIL/Coal Companies, the communication seeking further clarifications may explicitly indicate that it had been approved by the CMD, CIL/Coal Companies.


