Promotional Drilling: A programme of Promotional/NMET (Regional) drilling comprising 1.10 lakh meters in coal and 0.90 lakh meters in lignite has been drawn up in Annual Plan 2018-19 of CMPDI. The programme is under execution by MECL, DGMs of Nagaland &Assamand CMPDI.

As against this, the achievement of drilling upto the month of September, 2018 is 0.54 lakh meter, against the target of 0.78 lakh meter, which is 69% of the target.

Overall Progress of Detailed Drilling in 2018-19: For 2018-19, a target of 13.00 lakh meter of drilling (Departmental: 4.80 lakh meter, Outsourcing: 8.20 lakh meter) has been envisaged in the Annual Plan of MoC. As against this, 6.37 lakh meter of drilling has been carried out up to the month of September, 2018 against the target of 5.49 lakh meter, which is 116% of the target.
