

THE YEAR AT A GLANCE

Introduction

The Ministry of Coal has the overall responsibility of determining policies and strategies in respect of exploration and development of coal and lignite reserves, sanctioning of important projects of high value and for deciding all related issues. These key functions are exercised through its public sector undertakings, namely, Coal India Limited (CIL) and Neyveli Lignite Corporation Limited (NLCIL) and Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) a joint sector undertaking of State of Telangana and Government of India with equity capital in the ratio of 51:49.

Coal Reserves in India

308.802 billion tonnes of coal reserves have been estimated by the Geological Survey of India (as on 01.04.2016). The reserves have been found mainly in the States of Jharkhand, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana and Maharashtra.

Lignite Reserves in India

The Lignite reserves in the country have been estimated at around 44.59 billion tonnes by the Geological Survey of India (1.4.2016). The major deposits are located in the State of Tamil Nadu, followed by Rajasthan, Gujarat, Kerala, West Bengal, Jammu & Kashmir and Union Territory of Puducherry.

Coal Production:

The overall production of Coal for 2016-17 was projected at 724.71 MT. During the period April to December 2016 the actual production was 453.10 MT compared to 445.42 MT during corresponding period of 2015-16, showing a growth of 1.7%. Company-wise details of coal production from CIL, SCCL and Others are given below:-
