Subject: Addendum to the Minutes of the 47th meeting of the Standing Committee on Safety in Coal Mines held on 13th April, 2022 in New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Parliamentary Affairs, Coal and Mines.

In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even no. dated 13.5.2022 vide which minutes of the 47th meeting of the Standing Committee on Safety in Coal Mines in Coal Mines held on 13th April, 2022 in New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Parliamentary Affairs, Coal and Mines were circulated. Further, after incorporating corrections/additions brought forth by few members, the revised minutes of the subject meeting were circulated vide letter of even number dated 5th July, 2022.

- In addition to the record note of discussions mentioned in the aforesaid minutes of the meeting, the following issues raised by Shri Sanjay Singh, President (BMS) shall also be included:-
- Accidents are increasing due to shortage of front line supervisors in which about 2700 posts are vacant and appointment of junior mining officers, in which vacancies of more than 1000 posts are present, should be given onetime promotion without delay.
- ii) The safety budget of the year should be fully utilized in all the companies, it should be ensured that the responsibility of the concerned officers should be fixed in case of non-utilization. The L1 system should be abolished from the tender of safety goods.
- At present about 450 million tonnes of coal standing on pillar is lying in the underground mines of Coal India. With the help of planning department, get out safely after conducting a scientific study.
- iv) There is huge amount of dust in all mega projects of OCM in Coal India, necessary and urgent measures need to be taken in NCL, MCL, SECL, BCCL and other companies.
- V) In most of the subsidiaries of Coal India, open mining is becoming

vertical due to environmental, forest clearance and land acquisition. Benching is coming to an end. The dangers of disaster are increasing. Especially SECL's Gevra, Deepka, Kusmunda mines. Small open mines and newly opened mines are also not able to open due to land acquisition and adequate compensation. Cooperation of the ministry is expected.

vi) The tripartite security talks in all the companies of Coal India are pending for the last 02 to 03 years, meetings should be held without delay.
