Shri Haribhai Parathibhai Chaudhary is the Union Minister of State in the Ministry of Mines and Ministry of Coal. He has also served as Union Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs from November, 2014 to July, 2016 and as Union Minister of State in the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), from July, 2016 to September, 2017. A Member of Parliament from Banaskantha constituency in North Gujarat, Shri Chaudhary was born on 20th July, 1954 at Jagana Village in Palanpur Taluka of Banaskantha District in Gujarat State. He is 4th time M.P. from the same constituency. He passed M.Com(I) from Bombay University, Maharashtra. He is an industrialist and agriculturist and a known philanthropist. He has held various organizational positions in the Bharatiya Janata Party, including the Vice-President, Gujarat State BJP from 2005-2010. He has widely travelled abroad. He also represented India in the International Parliamentary Union in which about 550 parliamentarians from 145 countries participated.

Shri Chaudhary has served actively on different Parliamentary Standing Committees like Urban and Rural development, Government assurances, finance, public accounts, commerce, transport and tourism, petroleum and natural gas and consultative committees of the Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Petroleum and Ministry of Finance.

He also takes keen interest in different social activities. He also runs two schools with an enrolment of about 5,000 students.

He is married to Smt. Jawalben Haribhai Chaudhary and has two sons and one daughter.
